- I will do the very best to make the NLU experience fun for my child.
- I will help my child enjoy the NLU experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, providing transportation, or getting my child extra help and gym time to improve their skills.
- I will teach my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability and I will do the same.
- I will communicate to family members and friends who attend games and practices that they are also expected to meet these standards of conduct.
- I will not use drugs, alcohol, and tobacco or carry weapons while in contact with players.
- I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in NLU events.
